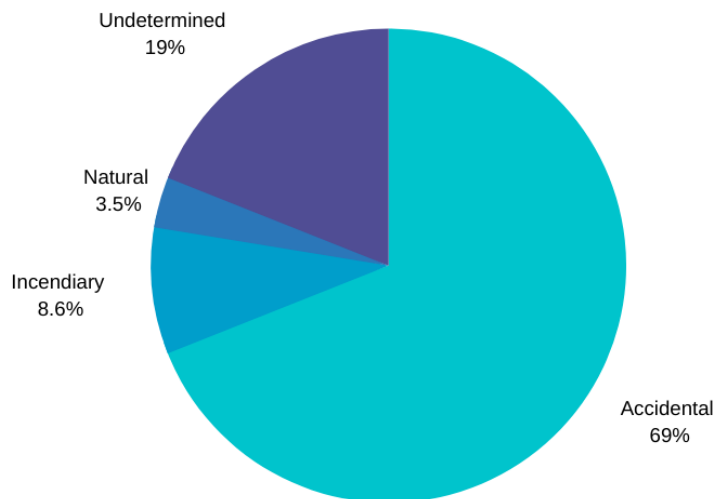
Most reported fire type for the month
