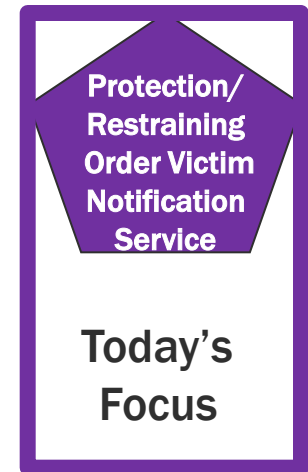
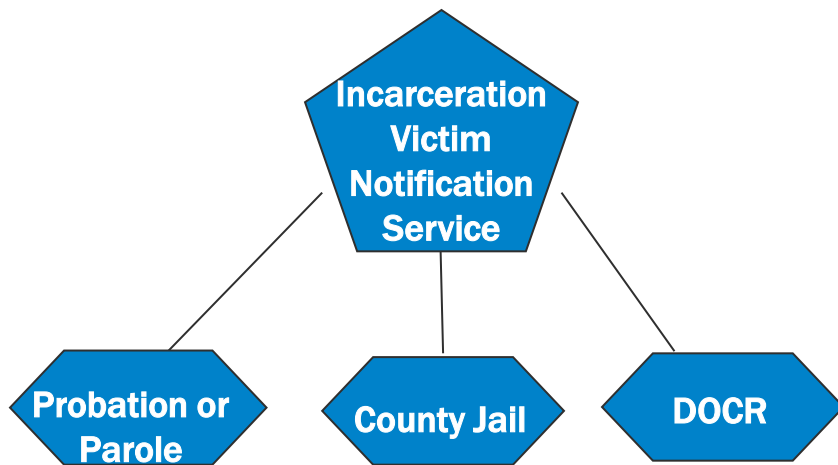

BUSINESS PRACTICES

- **Work with victims to sign them up**
 - Explain to them how the program works
 - If they'd like phone calls, set PIN together and get an appropriate, correct number
 - Sign them up when you get back from court
- **Remember and Prepare for the PIN Number and Telephone Issues**

CONCLUSION

■ Potential Action Steps:

- Sign up for one or more notifications to experience the system
- Find out your agency's policy; AARC Example
- Develop a strategy for working with clients to sign them up
- Sign up for notifications concurrently with clients for the first few to test
