We write on behalf of Discovery Communications, LLC (“Discovery”) regarding an incident involving unauthorized access to Discovery corporate documents. Please see the attached notification sent to more than 250 residents of your state today. Please note that available log information indicates that the files in question were accessed only twice by IP addresses not associated with Discovery Communications, most likely from a white-hat security researcher who was researching the issue and through whom Discovery indirectly learned of the issue. Accordingly, we have no reason to believe that any of the information has been or will be misused.

I am writing to let you know of an incident involving the potential disclosure of Discovery Communications, LLC (“Discovery”) documents to unauthorized parties. Discovery uses certain enterprise cloud services to store and exchange corporate documents. We recently learned from a third party that certain folders had been shared by Discovery staff with external business partners through this type of platform in such a way that the folders could be accessed by other parties.

Upon review of the documents in question, we identified a consumer marketing list from several years ago that included your name, address, email, and date of birth. We do not have any reason to believe that there was widespread access to or use of this information as a result of this issue, but we are notifying you out of an abundance of caution. No credit card or other financial information, or government issued identification numbers (i.e. social security numbers, tax ID numbers, social insurance numbers) were stored within this document.

Discovery is strongly committed to protecting the privacy and security of our customer information, and immediately upon learning of this incident, we disabled access to these folders, and we are reviewing additional security measures relating to this cloud-based document storage platform.
