Parrell,

I received a telephone call from Andy Shriner, Director of Government Affairs, with CenturyLink

He contacted our office to report a data breach that occurred about a year ago but discovered last month.

He said that there were 35 states impacted, though he did not have individual figures for the number of consumers. He said that no sensitive information was breached, but instead consisted of name, addresses, telephone numbers, and e-mail addresses. He said that neither social security numbers nor bank accounts were accessed.

He said that CenturyLink will be creating a website and sending letters to consumers.
