RE: Forensic Medical Examinations

New coverage, new reimbursement request forms

## ATTENTION REQUIRED

The 2007 Legislative Assembly made changes to N.D.C.C. § 12.1-34-07, relating to forensic medical examinations (sexual assault exams). These changes are:

- Separate amount authorized for reimbursement of Emergency Medical Treatment & Labor Act (EMTALA) screening;
- Reimbursement coverage extended to include <u>non-acute</u> examinations performed on child victims of alleged criminal sexual conduct (such as allegations of ongoing sexual abuse of a child);
- Changes are retroactive to May 23, 2009.

The Office of Attorney General has revised the Forensic Medical Examination Reimbursement Request Form to reflect these changes. The new forms are being distributed over the next few days to all North Dakota medical facilities and programs that receive Sexual Assault (rape) kits. Once you receive the new forms, please discard any old forms.

You will note that the new 1-page triplicate form has a unique pre-printed number on the top right-hand side. The medical provider retains the PINK copy to track the reimbursement request and payment and submits the white and yellow copy to the Crime Laboratory (along with the supporting documentation). The unique number on the top of the form is printed on the reimbursement check issued by this office. This will make it easy for the medical provider's billing department to credit the payment against the corresponding request form. Instructions for proper completion and mailing are printed on the reverse of the triplicate form.
