Thank you for your letter of May 30, 1989, in which you have requested approval of amendments to the North Dakota Uniform Complaint and Summons.

I have had an opportunity to review the proposed amendments, and pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 39-06.1-07, I do approve the amendments to the Uniform Complaint and Summons as outlined in your May 30, 1989, letter to me.

You have also stated in your letter that it is proposed that the Notification Form be delivered to persons charged as a separate document instead of being printed on the reverse side of the Uniform Complaint and Summons. N.D.C.C. § 39-06.1-07 does not require that the Notification Form be found on the reverse side of the Uniform Complaint and Summons. This provision requires only that the Notification Form be "delivered" with the Uniform Traffic Complaint and Summons to persons charged with an offense. Your proposal to deliver a separate Notification Form with the Uniform Complaint and Summons is not prohibited by law.
