Thank you for your letter dated July 7, 1987, regarding coverage of the Podiatric Board of Examiners' Secretary/Treasurer under the State Bonding Fund.

The State Bonding Fund provides blanket fidelity bond coverage to public employees of the state and its political subdivisions. N.D.C.C. § 26.1-21-01(4) states that a "'public employee' does not include a person employed by an occupational and professional board or commission under title 43 or by the state bar association." The State Board of Registry in Podiatry is a professional board under N.D.C.C. Title 43. Therefore I must regretfully inform you that the employees of your board do not qualify for fidelity bond coverage under the State Bonding Fund.
