RE: Annexation - Procedures When Adjoining Counties

This is in reply to your letter of August 13, 1963, concerning Chapter 147 of the 1963 Session Laws. You state hte following facts and questions:

We would also like to have your interpretation as to the meaning of the word 'annexing' as found in Section 15-27 05 where the word is used in this manner: 'In the event that a majority of members of each committee fail to approve the annexation, the county superintendent of the county in which the annexing district is located shall submit the petition..."

The procedure followed thus far and as we understand as required with regard to the process of annexation of a school district, or a portion of a school district in one county to a school district in an adjoining county is as follows:
