Pursuant to your letter request of April 10, 1958, please be advised that it is the opinion of the attorney general's office that it is mandatory for the county judge to furnish blank probate forms, at the expense of the county, for use in estate proceedings in his court if, in his discretion, he believes such forms to be necessary for the making of proper records in his office or for efficiently transacting the business of his office.
