Legislative Amendments

The 67th Legislative Assembly followed the recommendations from the 2019-2020 Report and amended the civil asset forfeiture reporting requirements to remove duplicative requirements and make the reporting less burdensome on local law enforcement, while requiring additional information be included in the civil asset forfeiture judgments. These changes took effect on August 1, 2021.

As a result, beginning with the report for the fiscal year 2021-2022 (which will issue on November 1, 2022), civil asset forfeiture report forms submitted by local law enforcement agencies and the narcotics tasks forces will be included as part of the annual report issued by this agency.

SUMMARY INFORMATION

Judicial Districts

The state has eight judicial districts each comprised of several counties. Each county has a two-digit county code, assigned alphabetically. When a civil asset forfeiture case is filed, it is assigned a case number consisting of the two-digit county code, the year, CV (to designate that it is a Civil case), and a unique five-digit case number.

Currency

Forfeited currency is divided among the agencies involved in the investigation and prosecution of the case. The number of agencies receiving funds and the cost share ratio depends on the jurisdiction and how the case originated, among other factors.

DISAGGREGATED INFORMATION

Currency

The disaggregated forfeited cash is reported by judicial district and county because the narcotics task forces serve multiple counties, and each county also may include multiple law enforcement agencies. Proceeds from civilly forfeited assets from a case originating with a local law enforcement agency may be divided among different agencies, or in different percentages, than the assets from a case originating with a narcotics task force, even though the same criminal justice agencies may be involved.
