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An omission was noted on the issued List of Approved Chemical Testing Devices for July 1, 2024. The reference to chapter 39-20 of the North Dakota Century Code in the first paragraph of the documents was inadvertently left out as follows:

Original first paragraph:

*Each of the following Intoxilyzer® 8000\* has been inspected on the date indicated below by a Field Inspector appointed, trained, certified, and supervised by the State Toxicologist and has been found to be in good working order by such Inspector, and is therefore approved by the State Toxicologist as a device for the analysis of breath to determine alcohol concentration, in accordance with Section 20.1-13.1, 20.1-15, 39-06.2, and/or 39-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code.*

This paragraph should state:

*Each of the following Intoxilyzer® 8000\* has been inspected on the date indicated below by a Field Inspector appointed, trained, certified, and supervised by the State Toxicologist and has been found to be in good working order by such Inspector, and is therefore approved by the State Toxicologist as a device for the analysis of breath to determine alcohol concentration, in accordance with Section 20.1-13.1, 20.1-15, 39-06.2, **39-20**, and/or 39-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code.*
