## OFFICIAL MEMO

**TO:** Licensed Manufacturers, Licensed Distributors, and Charitable Gaming Organizations

**FROM:** North Dakota Office of Attorney General, Gaming Division

**RE:** Transition to Online Gaming Licensing System – Paper Applications Not Accepted

### NOTICE

Effective immediately, **do not submit paper license applications or payments** to the Gaming Division.

- Paper applications **will not be accepted**.
- Payments submitted outside the online licensing system **will be returned**.

The North Dakota Gaming Division is preparing to launch a new online gaming licensing system, which will be used for all charitable gaming-related licenses and renewals for Fiscal Year 2027. All applications and renewals will be completed online through a web-based submission system. If a Fiscal Year 2026 license is required, **applications may still be submitted through the current licensing process at this time**.

Because this is the initial implementation of the online licensing system, all applicants will be required to complete the full application during their first submission. In future years, previously entered information will automatically be carried forward, and applicants will only need to update any changes at renewal.

All gaming-related licenses will be submitted directly to the Gaming Division through the online licensing system. License applications will no longer be submitted through the Attorney General Licensing Division. This transition represents a significant change to the licensing process and is intended to provide a more efficient and timely experience for all stakeholders.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Manufacturers and Distributors will access the online licensing system first during their designated application window.
- Charitable gaming organizations will follow with a 90-day application window.
- Organizations may begin preparing required documents, such as rental agreements and site authorizations; however, all documents will be uploaded online at the time of license renewal.
- Additional instructions, training opportunities, and system guidance will be provided prior to system launch.

Please be patient as the Gaming Division completes system testing. Further communications with detailed instructions will be issued soon. This memo serves as official notice: do not submit paper applications or payments. For questions or additional guidance, please contact the Gaming Division.
