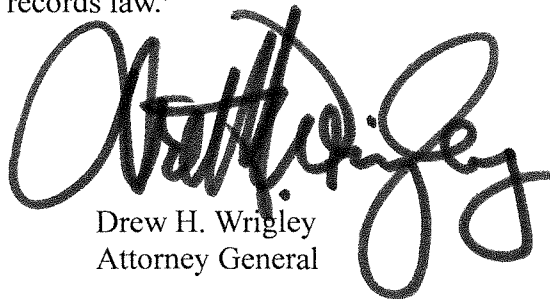

SUMMARY OPINION¹

Holli Jo Kronberg requested an opinion from this office under N.D.C.C. § 44-04-21.1 asking whether the Dickey County Senior Citizens Center² (Center) violated N.D.C.C. § 44-04-18 by not responding to three open records requests. Ms. Kronberg alleges that she made a records request on October 22, 2025, which was sent through the United States Postal Service. She further alleges that she sent additional requests on November 3, 2025, and November 18, 2025, by email.³ The Center states that it has reviewed its records and did not receive either the letter or the two emails from Ms. Kronberg. This office must base this opinion on the facts provided by the Center.⁴ Because the Center never received the requests, it had no obligation to respond and therefore did not violate the open records law.⁵
